### INCREASE IN DUES PAYMENT

Section 2, Article X: Fees and Dues of our By-Laws reads as follows: **On or before April 1st of each year, all Members,including Life Members, shall pay the Grand Lodge per capita fee, Grand Lodge per capita insurance assessment, and State Association dues, in addition to the appropriate regular (\$39) or Life Member Dues (\$19) as specified in the remainder of this section.**
