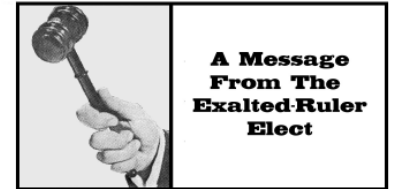

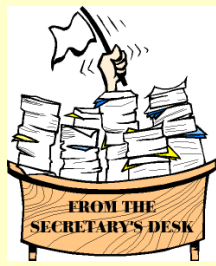

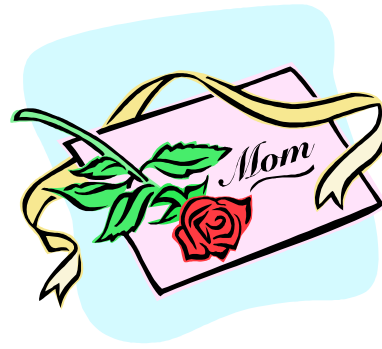
AUTISM RAFFLE
