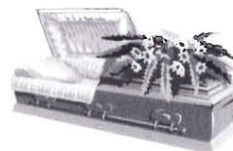

News from the Floor

Video Security cameras and a front door entry system will be installed soon. A new stove for the upstairs kitchen and new beer coolers will also be in soon. Ed and Pat Volta attended the 'Elks on the Trail' ceremony and laid a wreath from the Saugus-Everett Lodge to commemorate the event. Thanks Ed & Pat! The Lodge passed a By-Law change increasing the compensation of the Secretary and Treasurer to \$6,000 per year. Henry's Caterers was selected as the caterer of choice for the Parkview Room. All rental parties will receive specially designed Parkview Room banquet and buffet menus to make their arrangements with Henry's. The Special Needs Committee continues to raise funds for their program. They recently raised \$1,340 in watch and clock sales at the State Convention. They also received a \$300 donation from the Grand Lodge of Masons and a \$100 donation from a Saugus-Everett Member. The Lodge donated \$500 to the Mass Elks Scholarship as part of the Ed Volta appreciation Night held last month; \$50 to the Metro North DD Golf Tournament; \$50 to the East District DD Golf Tournament; \$200 to the Everett High School Band for the purchase of flags for their Memorial Service; we donated use of the parking lot to the Saugus High School Cheerleaders for their car wash fundraiser and Frank 'Duke of Earl' Merlina, Jr. was presented with a plaque for his contributions to the Special Needs program including the 'Wishing Well' in front of the Lodge.
