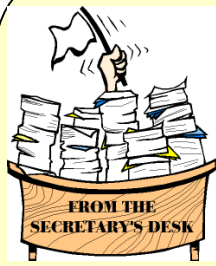
We will be having two meetings in June. The summer schedule will take effect with just one meeting in July and August on the fourth Monday. I would love to see more members coming to the lodge meetings.
